

Red pandas

Conservation Status

Red pandas have to be around 2500 to 10,000. They are endangered.

Habitat

Red pandas live in the Himalaya and northern Myanmar (Bruma) to the west Sichuan and Yunnan provinces of China. They are also found suitable habitat in Nepal, India and Tibet. Red panda's habitat is high mountains and bamboo forests with a high altitude.

Diet



Red pandas eat: Bamboo, some types of roots and succulent grasses, fruits, insects and grubs, and are known to kill and eat birds and small mammals.

Threats

Red pandas are being treated with something wrong with the grass (the grasses are dieing) and

at loss and degradation. Red pandas are being treated with habitat loss and degradation (the grasses are dieing) and human interference and poaching, poaching means when red pandas are being haunted.

Lifespan

Red pandas live around 23 years. They're life expectancy is to 12 to 14 years old. Red pandas breed once a year in early winter. The females come into heat in January or February and it lasts one to three day. Adult red pandas rarely interact with each other outside of mating season. Red pandas have 1-4 cubs born after 135 day.
